The NGE Group,

in consortium with Webuild and Equans France for the second design-build contract of Line 15 West;

appoints Anne Bocquet to lead the largest design-build project in the Group's history.

The NGE Group, the fourth largest construction group in France, in a consortium with Webuild and Equans France, confirms Anne Bocquet as project director to oversee the execution of the design-build contract for Lot 2 of Line 15, Western section of the Grand Paris Express. NGE is the lead contractor for this €1.38 billion project.

A graduate of the École Polytechnique, Anne Bocquet has over 27 years of experience in managing complex projects in public interest sectors such as shipbuilding, civil nuclear engineering, and transportation infrastructure engineering.

Anne Bocquet began her career in the defense sector, spending 12 years at Naval Group where she worked on submarine and reactor test construction projects, eventually becoming the Director of Operations. She then joined AREVA from 2009 to 2013 in the Risk & Opportunity department before moving to Ingerop, an engineering and construction consultancy firm, in 2013 as Project Director. There, she participated in the studies for the CIGEO project and the management of the infrastructure for Line 17 of the Grand Paris Express, where she first encountered the NGE teams on Lot 2.

Anne Bocquet joined the NGE Group in September 2023 and became part of the team responsible for responding to the design-build tender for Lot 2 of Line 15, Western section of the Grand Paris Express, in partnership with Webuild, Equans France, as well as the architectural firms AIA Life Designers, Dubuisson Architecture, and Richez Associés.

Her career, focused on major new construction projects, allows her to now lead an infrastructure project on the longest metro line in France, from the design phase to commissioning.
